

Lambeth United Church Reopening Protocol

Welcome to Worship!

As we resume worship in person again, our intent is to keep everyone safe by following protocols in keeping with Ministry of Health and United Church of Canada guidelines. In order to do so, alterations to our worship services and cooperation from all of us will be required. The following protocol has been discussed and prepared by the Reopening Committee which consisted of Matt Davidson (Chair), Rev. Matthew Penny, Alan Davidson, Jan Linner, Judy King, Barb Sutherland, Julie Allen, Roger Polgar and Betty Poole.

WORSHIP PROTOCOL

The church will open at approximately 10:15 to 10:20am, prior to the Sunday service.

Masks or Face Coverings will be required to be worn by anyone entering the building and throughout the service, unless unable to do so for medical reasons.

Hand Sanitizer will be available upon entry and in the Narthex – we encourage you to use it.

Worshippers will be asked for a name & phone number in order to track contacts if necessary – this will be kept in a sealed envelope and only used if the Health Unit requires the information.

The lift will be operational each Sunday for those requiring assistance to the main floor.

Pews will be marked to allow physical distancing.

To limit contact between worshippers, Ushers will seat people starting at the front of the church. After the service, we will exit starting with pews from the back.

All children will be welcome but at this time there will be no children's time downstairs during the service.

Offering plates will be located on the tables in the Narthex. They will not be passed throughout the congregation.

We will enjoy music by listening rather than singing.

Until we are assured it is safe for everyone, we will need to forgo our coffee and conversation time and simply exit the building immediately following the service.
